



## **My Pool is Leaking!!**

If you have serious and visible leaks call us straight away on 9876 2931.

If you suspect you have a leak in your pool but do not know where it is, the first step is to figure out how much and when the pool is leaking. Carry out this simple test before doing anything else.

1. Make a mark with a marker or blue-tac inside your skimmer box of the current or 'normal' water level. Allow the filter to run it's normal 8 hour schedule or if possible run for the next 24 hours. After 24 hours (try to keep the time as close to 24 hours as possible) measure the drop.
2. Refill the pool to the previous mark and this time turn your system off. After 24 hours measure the drop in water level. Record the results and call us on 9876 2931.

This test allows us to decipher where the leak may be. If there is no difference between the two measurements then the leak is likely not within the plumbing of your pool and is potentially located at the main drain, behind a pool light or in the case of above ground pools could be a leak in the liner. If there is a difference in the results then this suggests that the leak is effected by pressure and therefore most likely within the plumbing of your pool.

For most leaks we will refer our customers to a specialised leak detector.
